The problem.

Due to increased global travel and decreased use of pesticides, bed bugs, lice, ants and other insects are found in everything from college residences, hospitals, hotels and virtually all other types of housing throughout the United States.

How to avoid it.

Keep your living space clean and learn to spot signs of insects. For example, small red to reddish brown fecal spots on mattresses, box springs, bed frames, linens, upholstery, or walls; bites on your skin; trails of ants in kitchens or bathrooms.

What to do.

Within 24 hours RRSS Maintenance will dispatch to the area for initial assessment – if they cannot resolve, they will refer to Environmental, Health, and Safety (EHS), which should yield a response time of 24-48 hours.
